On the above listed date and time, I responded to the above listed location in reference to an unverified 911. Upon arrival, I made contact with the victim David Elsholz who had blood dripping out of his nose onto his chest and arms. David then provided the following interview. He was sleeping and woke up to "piss," after he "pissed" he sat down on his bed. Deeanne woke up and started yelling at him. David told her he didn't want to argue and he just wanted to sleep. Deeanne kept yelling at him, she then picked up glass cup and hit him in the nose causing him to bleed. David advised he grabbed a towel, wiped the blood from his nose and threw it at Deeanne. They

continued to argue until I arrived on scene. David stated he never hit Deeanne. David refused medical treatment for his nose. David then provided me a written statement and could provide no further information.

I then made contact with Deeanne Elsholz who was sitting on her bed in an upright position saying she needed Fire Rescue because she believed her ribs were broken. I then contacted Fire Rescue and had them respond to my location. While waiting for Fire Rescue to arrive Deeanne provided the following interview. She was sleeping in her bed when she awoke to David peeing on the bathroom floor. Deeanne said "what are you doing." David then walked into over to her and started hitting her in the face with a towel. Deeanne stated she told David to stop several times but he refused. Deeanne then grabbed a glass cup off her night stand and threw it at David which struck him in the nose causing him to bleed.

Deeanne ran into the bathroom and slipped on David's pee. David followed her in the bathroom and while she was on the floor David kicked her in her right ribs. Deeanne crawled out of the bathroom, grabbed her phone and dialed 911. She then wrapped the phone in a towel and threw it under the bed so the 911 operator could listen to what was going on. During my interview with Deeanne she kept changing her answer when it pertained to her being hit with the towel. She also told me David threw the towel on her and she never got hit in the face with the towel. I observed no injuries or redness to Deeanne's face or back. Deeanne could provide no further information. Fire Rescue 13 arrived on scene and checked out Deeanne. Fire Rescue advised her vitals were fine and did not believe she had cracked ribs. Deeanne stated she was now fine and refused to ride with Fire Rescue to the hospital.

I was unable to locate the glass cup in the bedroom due to the clutter in the bedroom. It should also be noted there was a large quantity of empty Natural Light beer cans throughout their bedroom and rest of the house. Both Deeanne and David appeared to be extremely intoxicated.

I photographed David's injuries and forwarded the film to the Forensic Services Section for processing.

I obtained a written statement from David. Deeanne refused to provide me with one. I issued David a Victim Witness Booklet/Domestic Violence Booklet/business card with case number.

I determined Deeanne was the primary aggressor of the altercation and advised her she was under arrest. Deeanne then advised she now was in severe pain and wanted to be transported by ambulance to the hospital. I had Fire Rescue 13 respond back to my location and transport her to Florida Hospital Zephyrhills. I followed Fire Rescue 13 to the hospital where she received X-rays on her ribs. The X-rays were negative for broken ribs. After medical clearance I transported her to Land O' Lakes jail without incident.

A warrants check on all parties met with negative results. No further action.
